We invite you to attend our 29th Annual Rally (19, 20, 21 APRIL 2024)
Another great 3 day event for fellow historic motorcycle enthusiasts and visitors.

VENUE: The Inverell Pioneer Village, Bundarra Road is muster point/check-in for the weekend.

Please register on arrival and receive your rally pack

CAMPING available-(tent \$15 / night. Non-powered sites \$15 / night, powered sites \$20 / night). Note that limited caravan space is available. *The on-site buildings cannot be used for accommodation*

Friday 19 April: Registration, Refreshments, Ride and Lunch. Discount entry to National Transport Museum

Inverell Pioneer Village, Bundarra Rd - Register upon arrival, receive your entry pack and complimentary refreshments. All bikes welcome - judging will be for *pre 1960 bikes.*

*Ride Details: Depart Pioneer Village at 11am for ride to Bundarra with stop en-route to inspect Tingha's quirky *Wing Hing Long Museum.* Lunch at Bundarra Sport & Rec Club. (lunch ticket required)

Total ride distance 100km approx

National Transport Museum 4 - 7pm. Half Price (\$10) entry to explore the 80+ motorcycles, 120 other vehicles and static displays. Present your Rally entry at the door to claim your entry discount.

#Saturday 20April: Refreshments, Judging, Choice of Ride and Lunch, Presentation Dinner

- Muster at the Pioneer Village: gates open 7:30am. Food, tea & coffee supplied (ticket required). Bikes will be marshalled into the relevant judging category lineup.
- Judging commences 9:00am

*Ride Details: Inverell -Ashford (lunch)-Inverell *Choice of either **Long Ride or Short Ride.***

- **Long Ride** will depart 10:30 sharp heading north along the Bannockburn Road toward Yetman. The route passes through Oakwood, Cherry Tree Hill, Graman and Wallangra. It continues north to Rocky Dam, turning south toward Coolatai, then back east to Wallangra and then east again to Ashford for lunch (lunch ticket required). (148km). Fuel is available in Ashford.
- **Short Ride** leaves at 11am and follows the same route to Wallangra where riders turn east to Ashford for lunch (90km) (lunch ticket required).
- Following lunch all riders will head south & return to Inverell (61km).

Total ride distances:- 210km (long ride) 150km (short ride)

Presentation Dinner: 6:30 for 7pm, Inverell RSM Club Evans St. (upstairs) Tickets purchased with your entry form. 2 course meal, bar facilities, raffles, presentation of Rally awards & trophies. RSM Courtesy Bus is available - phone 6722 3066 to arrange pick-up.

#Sunday 21 April: Refreshments, Swap Meet, Short Ride, Sausage sizzle brunch, Close of Rally

As previous years, a small motorcycle swap will be held at Pioneer Village. Please indicate if you are bringing items to sell on your entry form. Gold coin donation for a site.

*Ride Details: Short return ride through Elsmore Valley followed by a sausage sizzle brunch before you depart for home. **Total Ride Distance 33km approx**

NOTES

- Booking & check-in for camping essential upon arrival at Pioneer Village (Geoff 0419691169)
- Rides are marshalled & accompanied by a back-up vehicle (Rally entry sticker pick-up only).
- Backup vehicle will not wait for roadside repairs - bike to be loaded immediately.
- Owner/rider is responsible for securing their bike on the backup vehicle.
- Bikes are eligible for judging only if they are ridden to the Saturday marshalling area and then to the designated Saturday lunch stop (mechanical reliability is part of the judging criteria).
- Saturday Ride Bus - FREE for any Motorcycle Club Member entrant, partner or family member, add number to entry form. *Vacant bus seats may be offered on the day to other passengers.*
- Friday & Saturday lunch is by pre-purchased ticket which must be presented at the venue.
